SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

15 [18-601.1.

16 (a) An individual who has the human immunodeficiency virus may not knowingly 17 transfer or attempt to transfer the human immunodeficiency virus to another individual.

18 (b) A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor 19 and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$2,500 or imprisonment not exceeding 20 3 years or both.]

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2022.
