A PERSON MAY NOT BE DENIED THE RIGHT TO PURCHASE, OWN, POSSESS, OR CARRY A FIREARM UNDER THIS TITLE SOLELY ON THE BASIS THAT THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO USE MEDICAL CANNABIS UNDER TITLE 36, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CANNABIS ARTICLE.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2025.
